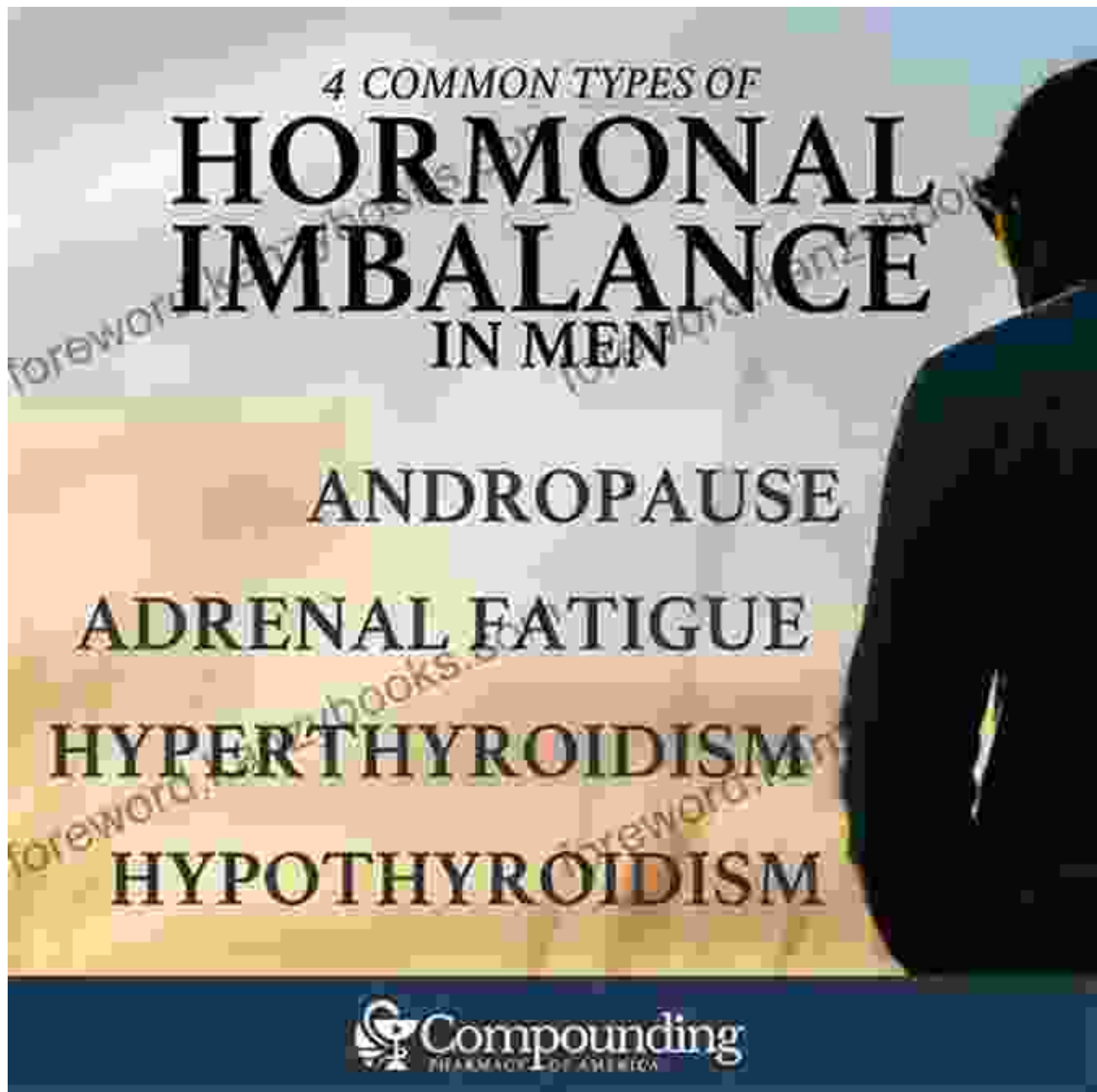
- **Primary infertility:** Occurs when a man has never been able to conceive.

Hormonal Imbalances



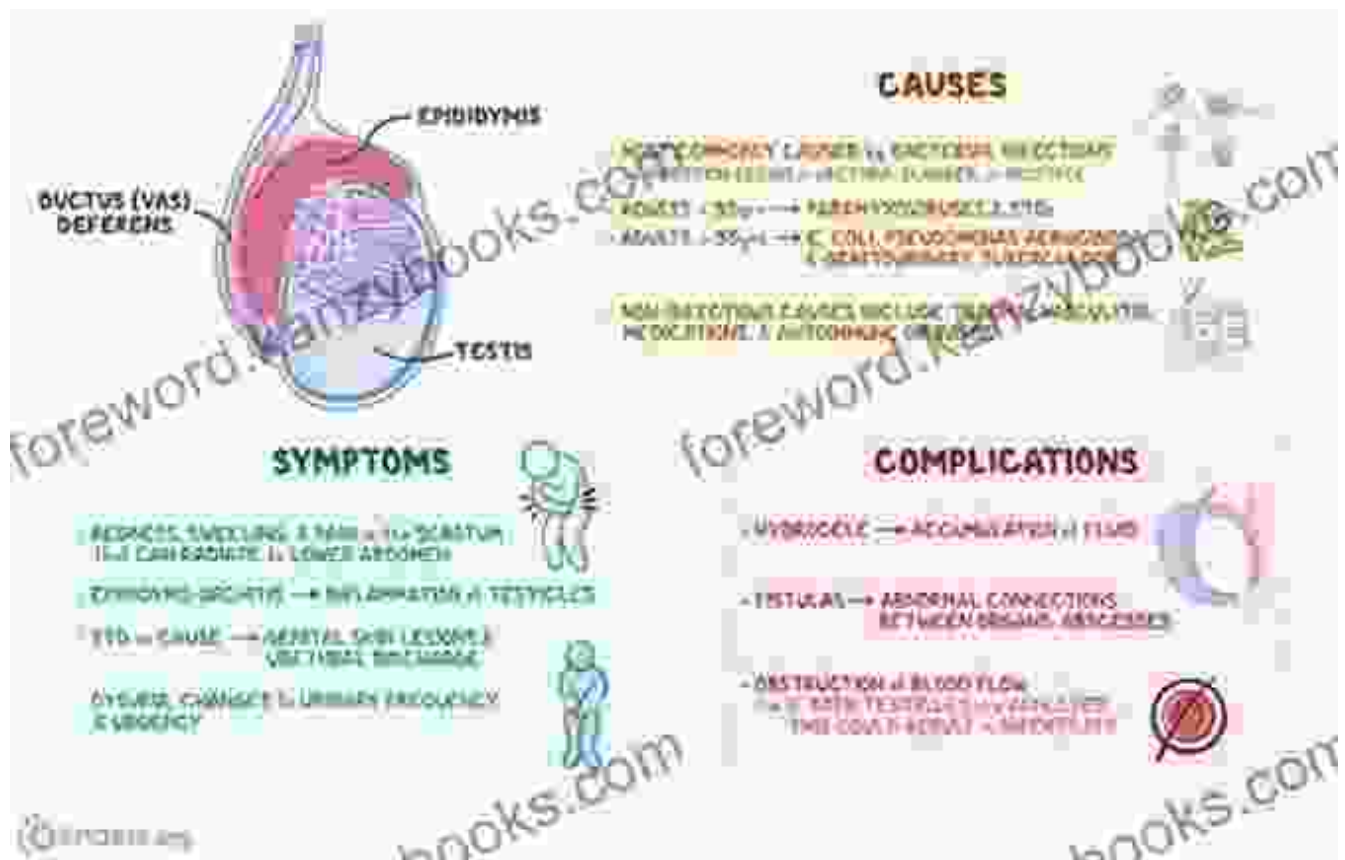

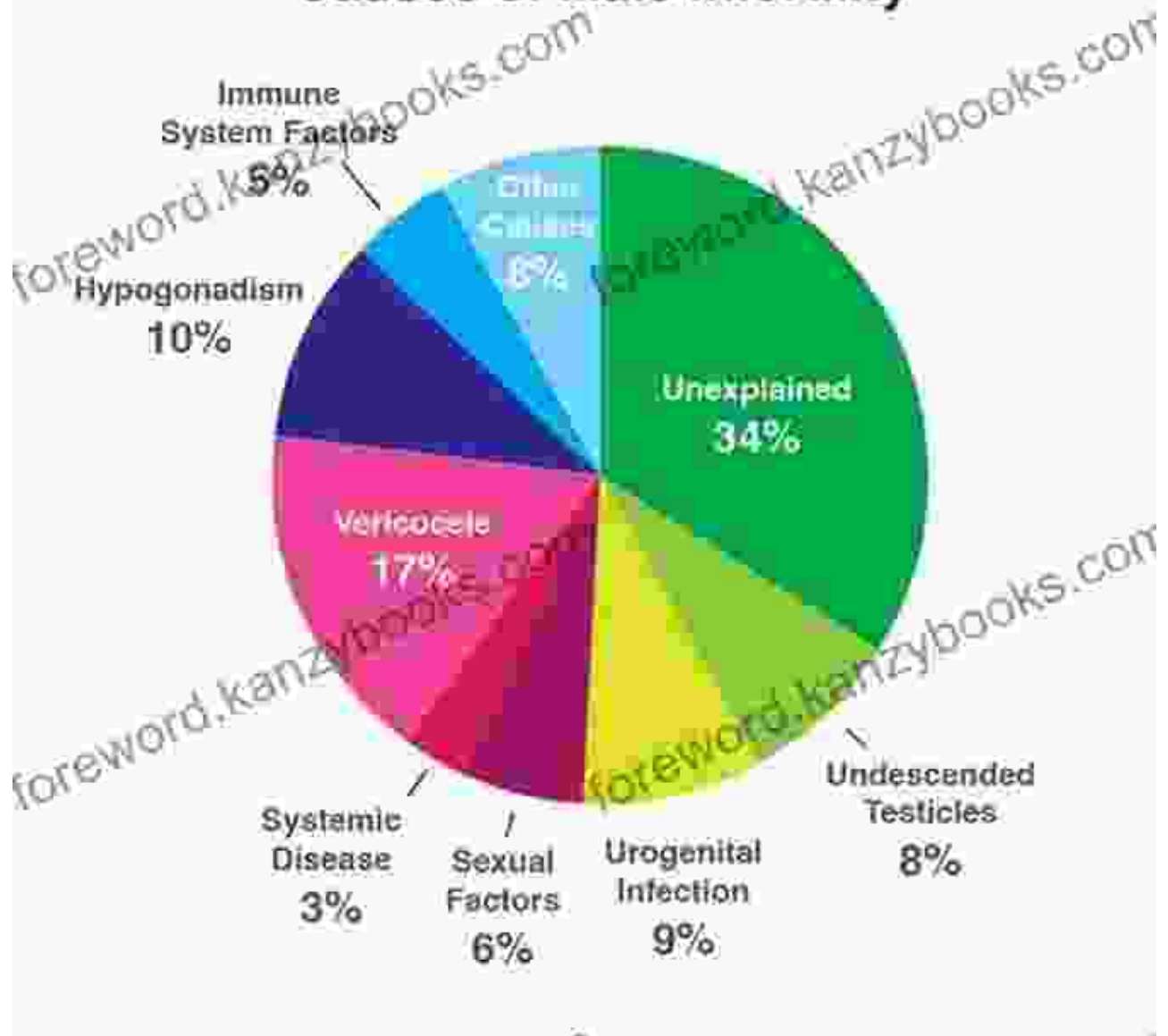
Testicular Infections

FACTORS THAT CAN AFFECT MALE FERTILITY



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SMOKING

Smoking significantly decreases both sperm count and sperm cell motility.



OVERHEATING THE TESTICLES

Excess temperature such as use of hot tubs, tight underwear can lower sperm production.



EXPOSURE TO TOXICITY

Exposure to toxins like benzene, pesticides, herbicides, etc. which can lower sperm count.



BEING OVERWEIGHT

Being overweight can negatively impact a man's sperm count and can decrease his libido.



ABNORMALITIES

Abnormalities in male reproductive system such as varicocele, undescended testes etc. are common infertility causes.



ALCOHOL ABUSE

Drinking alcohol can lower testosterone levels, cause erectile dysfunction and decrease sperm production.



Sexually Transmitted Infections



STIs like gonorrhea, chlamydia or syphilis can damage reproductive organs and cause infertility.

Usage of Recreational Drugs



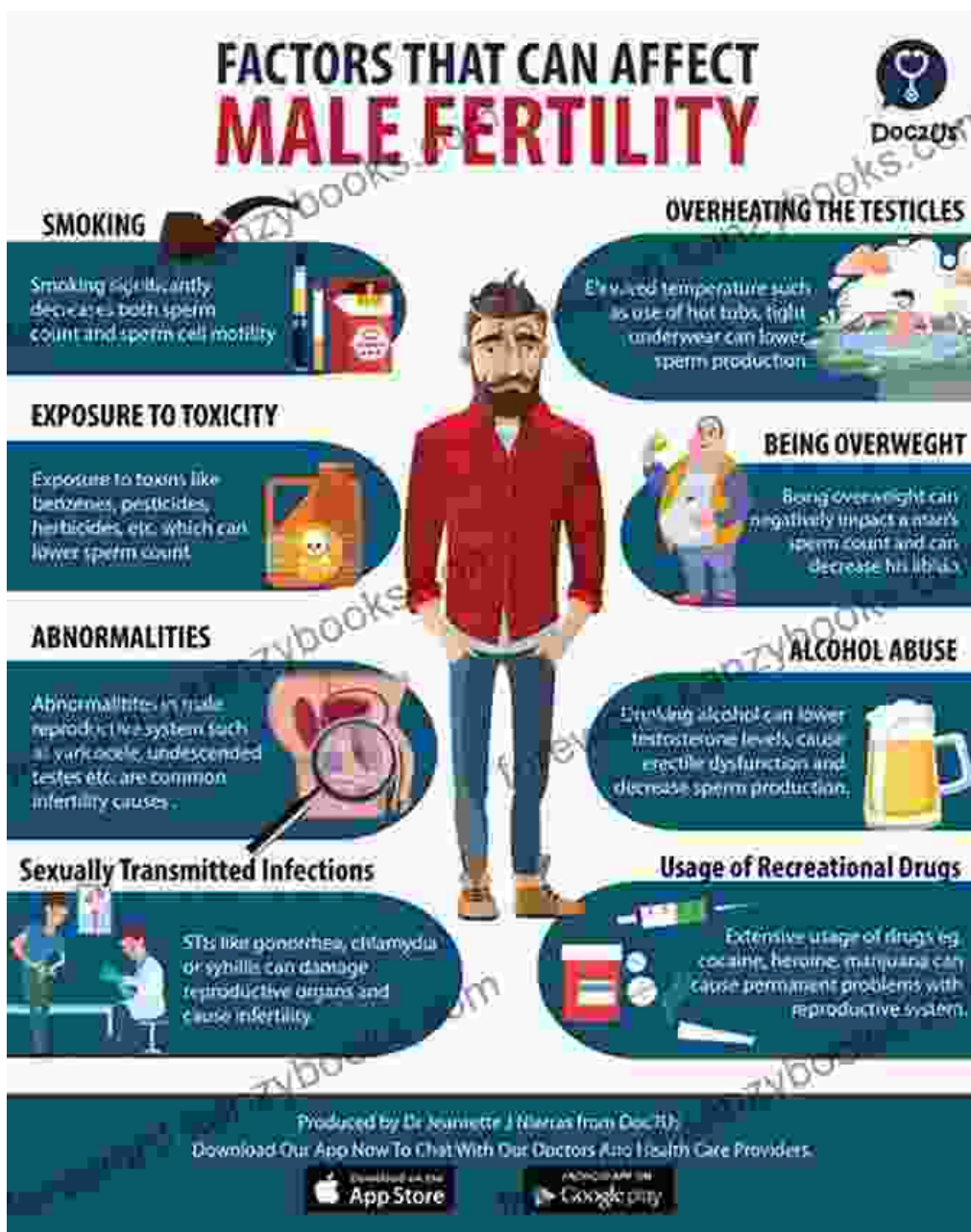
Extensive usage of drugs eg. cocaine, heroin, marijuana can cause permanent problems with reproductive system.

Medical Treatment



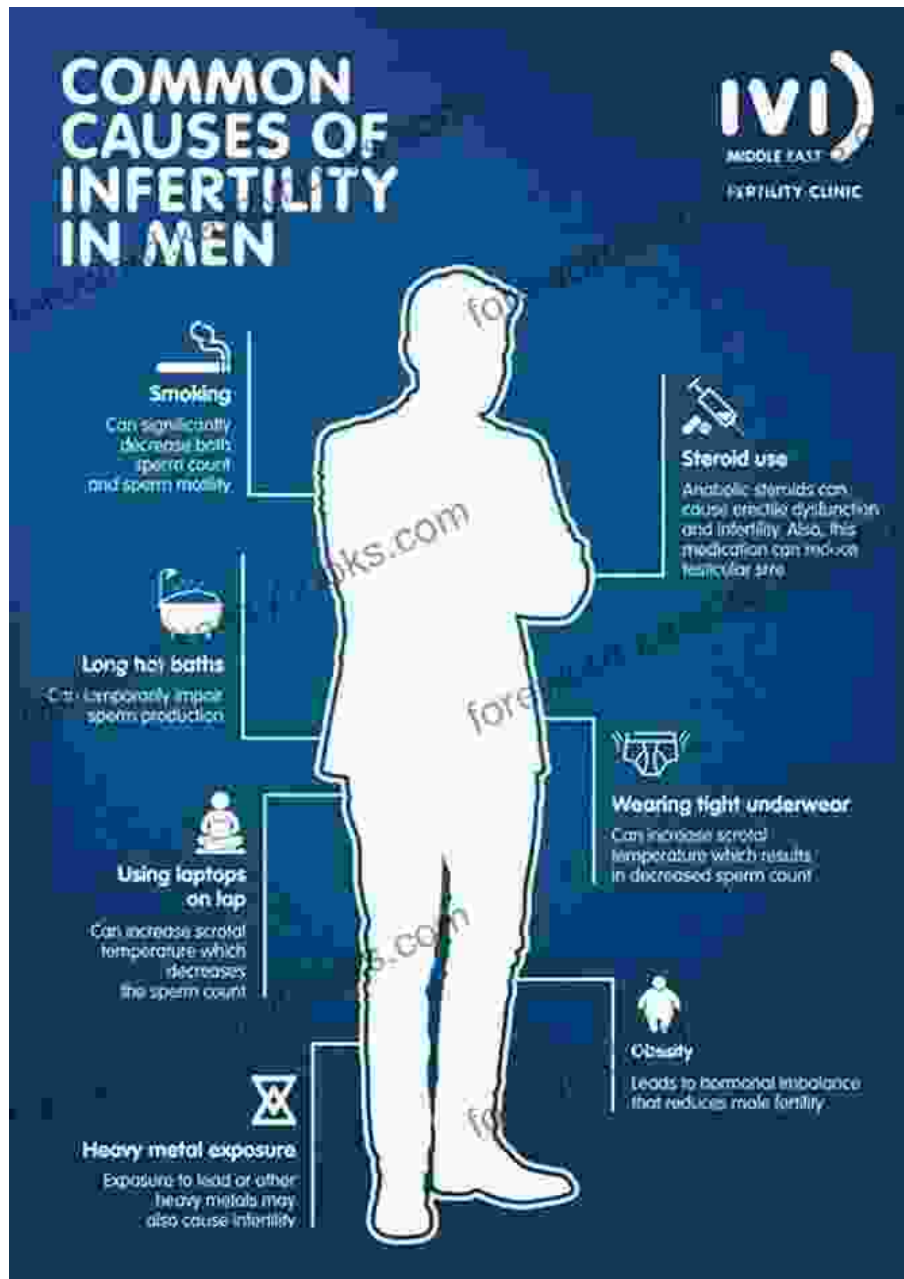
Medications, such as hormone replacement therapy and antibiotics, may be prescribed to address hormonal imbalances and infections.

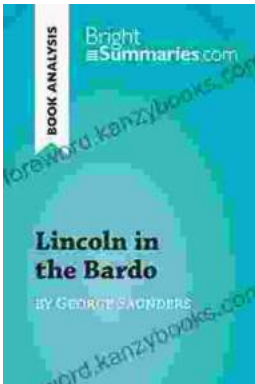
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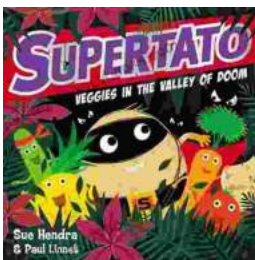


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
